



## Administration Guidelines/Policies Club Championships

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### 1. Purpose and Background

- 1.1 To guide the Surf Sports and Competition Committee in conducting and recording the Club Championships
- 1.2 To determine through a structured competition the victors of the various age group club champions and ultimate recipients of dedicated trophies.

### 2. Policy Statement

- 2.1 The Surf Sports and Competition Committee is charged with conducting the Club Championships in conjunction with club surf sports officials at a time, place, preferably conducted in December each year, as determined by the Surf Sports and Competition Committee.

### 3. Applicability

- 3.1 This procedure applies to all members of the Marcoola Surf Life Saving Club. The responsibility of implementing this policy/procedure rests with the Surf Sports and Competition Committee under the overview of the Board.

### 4. Statutory/Constitution/By-Laws Requirements

- 4.1 This procedure specifically relates to By-Laws 10.3.

### 5. Procedure

All Active members are encouraged to attend and participate regardless of competition experience. The individual Club Champion trophies are presented at the Club Annual Awards Dinner

### **Club Champion Categories**

Are awarded to both Male and Female in the following categories:

- Cadet
- Junior
- Senior
- Masters

### **Individual Club Champion**

There are 4 events that make up the individual Club Champion Award. Events as follows:

- Swim
- Board
- Sprints
- Flags

*Competitors must compete in all 4 events to be eligible for the Club Champion Award.*

### **Points Awarded**

The following points are awarded for placing's in each event:

- 1<sup>st</sup> 6 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> 5 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> 4 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> 3 points
- 5<sup>th</sup> 2 points
- 6<sup>th</sup> 1 point

### **Extra Points**

Extra points are awarded for participation in the following Club Events:

- 3 points: Attendance at doorknock or donation in lieu of attending to the value of \$100.

Extra points are also awarded for the following patrol hours:

- 20 hours over rostered patrol hours 1 point
- 100% of rostered patrols attendance 3 points
- 80% of rostered patrols attendance 2 points
- 60% of rostered patrols attendance 1 point

***All points added together decide the Club Champion in each category. The individual with the highest points is awarded the trophy.***

### **Patrol Team Relay**

At the Club Championships, a Patrol Team Relay is conducted. Patrol Teams consisting of 3 people compete in the patrol team relay. The event consists of a Board Paddle, Swim and Sprint. The points awarded in this event are counted towards the Champion Patrol Team Award, which is also presented at the Annual Dinner.

### **Points Awarded**

The following points are awarded for the event:

- Patrol Person Attendance: 2 points per patrol member, capped at a maximum of 10 points.
- Patrol Relay Attendance: 10 points, capped at one team
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place in the Relay            15 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in the Relay            10 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in the Relay            5 points

A maximum total point available per patrol is 35 points.
