Guideline Topic:	Lifesaving
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SECTION 1:: 2 x Club Patrol Inspections

Details::

1.1 Points Awarded as per the Buhk-Wilkes Champion Patrol Guidelines;
1 completed prior to Christmas, 1 completed after Christmas. To be conducted by the Club Captain or Vice-Captain or nominated assessor (in the case of their own patrols, it is to be conducted by a qualified assessor).

1.2 Max Points per Inspection ::350

1.3 Total Points Available :: 700

SECTION 2:: Member Attendance

Details::

2.1 Points awarded for each patrol completed and totalled at the end of season. In the event of a team completing fewer patrols than another in a season, an average of the seasons scores will be calculated, rounded and added to make up the shortfall.

Points Awarded::

2.2 All members of a patrol team are present either themselves or with arranged sub/s, maintaining award requirements for duration of patrol. (does not include SRC holders) ::10

2.3 Minimum numbers and awards are maintained with arranged sub/s ::5

2.4 Minimum numbers and awards not maintained by patrol team ::0

2.5 Max Points per Patrol ::10

2.6 Total Points Available ::Approx 140

SECTION 3:: Patrol Statistics Log Book

Details::

3.1 Points awarded for each patrol completed and totalled at the end of season. In the event of a team completing fewer patrols than another in a season, an average of the season's scores will be calculated, rounded and added to make up the shortfall. The patrol log shall be evenly divided up into 5 sections; with 100% completion of each section being worth 2 points, if all five sections are 100% completed correctly 10 points shall be awarded. A patrol must fully complete each section to be eligible for the 2 points per section.

Points Awarded::

3.2 Log book filled out 100% correctly and fully ::10

3.3 Max Points per Patrol ::10

3.4 Total Points Available ::Approx 120

SECTION 4:: Club Championships Patrol Relay

Details::

4.1 Points awarded for attendance and placement in the Club Championships Patrol Team Relay. Each patrol needs a minimum of 3 members to attend from their rostered patrol in order to be eligible for 'attendance' champion patrol points from the club championships and patrol relay. Patrols that combine members will not receive champion patrol points.

Points Awarded::

4.2 Attendance (per person, capped at 10) ::2

4.3 Relay Attendance (capped at one team) ::10

4.4 1st Place Relay ::15

4.5 2nd Place Relay ::10

4.6 3rd Place Relay ::5

4.6 Maximum Total Points Available ::35

SECTION 5:: Patrol Captain's Meetings Attendance

Details::

5.1 Points awarded to teams whose patrol captain or delegated proxy attends each face to face patrol captain's meeting. (3 meetings in total)

::100

5.2 Teams who's PC or VPC attend (or delegated proxy)

5.3 Total Points Available ::300

SECTION 6:: Skills Maintenance

Details::

6.1 Points awarded to teams who have all members on their patrol proficient in their base award (ie. – For SRC's holders = SRC, for BM holders = BM, for award members = ROC or F.A) by the 31st of November.

6.2 Teams who have all members proficient by 30th November ::20

6.3 Total Points Available ::20
