In an attempt to encourage existing members to utilise the Club Ski's the following Guideline was adopted:

GUIDELINE

- Members who wish to use a ski should register their interest with the Club Board & Ski Officer
- Members must be an active patrolling member, who holds a proficient Surf Rescue Certificate
 or higher. Any Surf Rescue Certificate holder under the age of 17 must use the ski under
 supervision as part of organised Club Training.
- The Club Board & Ski Officer will approve each individual to use the ski (based on competence). Once approved that person is able to use the ski whenever they want to.
- If the member wants to use the ski for training outside of Marcoola, approval must be given by the Club Board & Ski Officer.

Notes:

- Members should become competent on the plastic ski first, before attempting to use the fibreglass ski.
- Approval must be granted for members to use the competition double ski.
